“Just for Fun” Sparkling Chardonnay Pinot Noir NV A terrific fizz offering up apple & stonefruit scents, baked apple & peachy flavours - a tangy, dry finish.	\$15	\$180		
Hunter Valley “Teachers’ Retreat” Semillon 2010 Made in the traditional Hunter early picked style. This dry white is absolutely brimming with fresh herby flavours & the lemony tang that’s a perfect marriage with grilled seafood.	\$15	\$180		
Hawkes Bay (N.Z.) “Frayed Knot” Pinot Gris 2010 A light bodied white with delicate aromas of fresh pear & straw with a bright, juicy soft textured & very moreish palate. A sensational summer sipper!	\$15	\$180		
Marlborough (N.Z.) “The Bank” Sauvignon Blanc 2010 A zesty Kiwi Sauvignon Blanc tasting of green herbs, cut grass & passionfruit juiciness. Feels like a dip in the sea & tastes great with something fishy.	\$15	\$180

McLaren Vale (S.A.) “Time Out ” Shiraz 2009 Packed with lots of luscious blackberry, prune & mulberry fruit seasoned by a lick of smoky oak & some liquoricey spice. Geelong (Vic.) “Utopia” Pinot Noir 2010 Light in colour but full-flavoured with black cherries, mint, spice, strawberry & is augmented by a hint of stalk & an echo of the char on the French oak barrels it was aged in.	\$15	\$180		
Margaret River (W.A.) “Anchors Away” Cabernet Merlot Petit Verdot 2008 A really approachable red with a hint of juicy blackcurranty, mulberry fruit restrained by some leafy, herby freshness & darker olivey savoury-ness to close.	\$15	\$180		
Barossa Valley (S.A.) “Ring the Changes” Single Vineyard Shiraz 2008 This cheeky little red smells pretty spicy, a twist of black pepper & a sprinkling of nutmeg along with some plum skin & roast meat scents.
