Please spend the next week discussing a design with your child/ren, so you can make a plan for a hat/s, which could be made with parent support.

Our students really enjoy thinking up creative ideas and watching them come to life. Using equipment to make a hat e.g. stapler, scissors or sticky tape, is an integral part of the Science and Technology syllabus. Parents are encouraged to allow their child to design and create their own masterpiece. The opportunity to problem solve with hats that are e.g. too heavy and tip forward, or carrots or eggs that won't stay put on the hat, are fantastic learning curves.

If you are unable to make a hat with your child, please see Mrs Kelly as soon as possible. We are really looking forward to seeing all of the creativity from the students. We encourage reusing and recycling items as much as possible. To make the hat, you will require a sheet of cardboard in the chosen colour of the student/s.

In the interest of food allergies, it is not appropriate to use chocolate eggs or any other food item on their hat.

Please bring in your hat on Wednesday, 28 March, which is the day before the parade, so we can ensure each student has a hat.
